

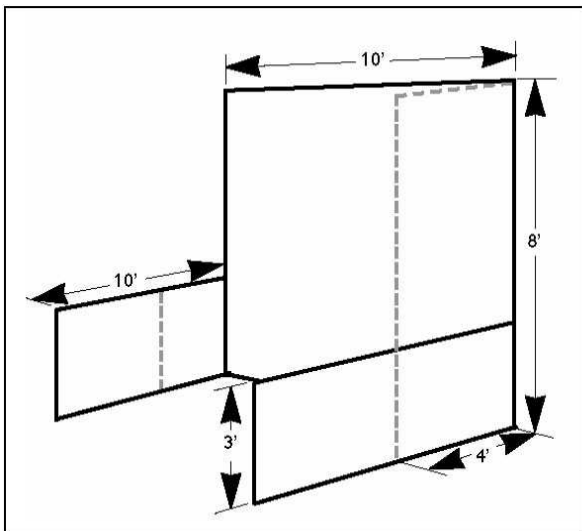


Show Management Policies

Literature Distribution

Exhibiting companies may distribute literature in their booth only. Exhibiting companies may not distribute literature anywhere outside of their booth including, but not limited to, in the registration area, on food tables in the exhibit hall or in other booths. Any literature that is distributed in a non-approved area will be collected by show management and disregarded.

Booth Configurations



Exhibits must be arranged as not to obstruct the general view nor hide the exhibits of others. A plan for specially built displays, not in accordance with Expo regulations, must be submitted to Expo Management at least sixty (60) days before the start of the Expo. Expo Management will attempt to accommodate exhibitor's request for a specially built display, but Expo Management retains sole discretion whether to permit a specially built display. Unless express written permission to the contrary is secured

from Expo Management in advance, regular and specialty built backwalls, including signs, may not exceed an overall height of 8' and must be freestanding. Low side dividers, including signs, between exhibits should not exceed 36" in height. If a high divider is desired, it shall not exceed 8' in height or extend from the backwall more than 4'. See diagram.

Labor Regulations

Due to local union regulations, exhibitors may hire an Exhibitor Appointed Contractor (EAC) to supervise installation and dismantling of a booth, but an EAC may not be used to install or dismantle a booth. Labor may be hired through SMGX for booth installation and dismantle. Please submit the EAC Application, which can be found in this exhibitor kit, to Show Management by March 31, 2009.

Security

Expo Management will employ guards and will take reasonable precaution to safeguard the exhibitor's property. However, Expo Management will not be liable for loss or damage to the property of the exhibitor or his representatives or employees from theft, fire, accident or any other cause beyond its control. **It is strongly encouraged that exhibitors remove any valuable items from their booth overnight.** Exhibitor agrees to protect, save and hold the Expo Management, the Mayor and City Council of Secaucus, NJ and the Meadowlands Exposition Center and all agents and employees thereof (hereinafter collectively called Indemnities), forever harmless for any damages or charges imposed for violations of any law or ordinance, whether occasioned by the negligence of the exhibitors or those holding under the exhibitor, and save, and hold harmless the Indemnities against and from any and all losses, costs, damage, from or out of or by reason of any accident or bodily injury or other occurrence to any person or persons, including the exhibitor, its agents, employees, and business invitees which arises from or out of or by reason of said exhibitor's occupancy and use of the exhibition premises, the hotel, or any part thereof.
